

Aluminite Resin

Egg by Dawn Herndon-Charles Alumilite with Buckeye Burl

Color is from Pearlex powder. The blank cured under pressure in a paint pressure pot.



Aluminite is a casting resin allowing you to cast intricate designs in workable plastic. As Dawn shows, the resin can be added to wood, making turning blanks. The addition of this resin turns formerly worthless but interesting wood into usable and interesting blanks for bird calls, pens and other unique and beautiful objects. Dawn took a class with Keith Latkner at Woodcraft to learn how to work with Alumilite and other casting materials. Keith will be doing a demo for Windy City this Fall.

Alumilite has a large web presence, and is available from many sources, including Amazon. The Aluminite web site (www.aluminite.com) is extensive with how-to videos, forums and lots of technical support.
